LENTEN PRACTICES

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat. Fasting is expected for persons in good health from age 18 until age 59. Fasting is understood as eating one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon persons from age 14 onwards.
