**Marriages:** Arrangements made at the Parish House at least 6 months prior to the date of the wedding.

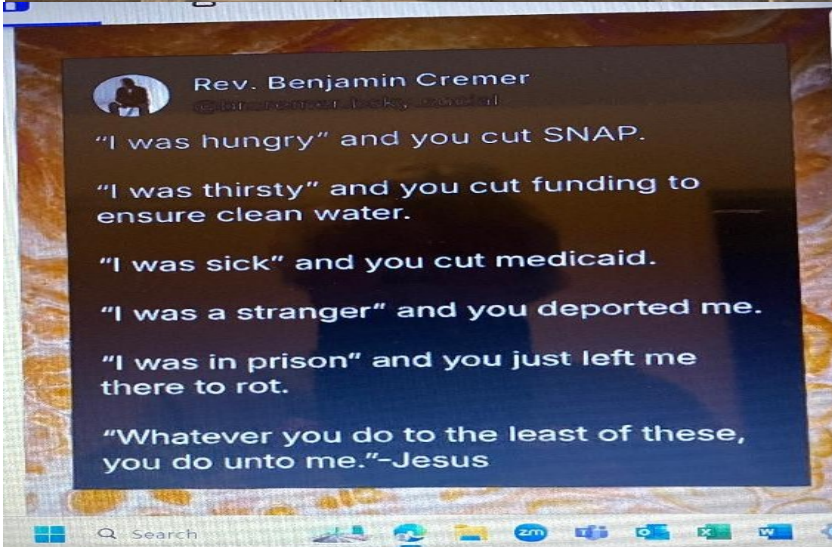
**Baptisms:** Contact the Parish House.
